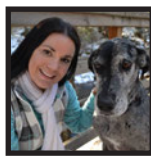

Dave Sanderson - *"From Turmoil to Triumph: How to get back on the Plane"*

Dave is an inspirational survivor, author, and nationally sought-out leadership speaker. When US Airways Flight 1549, or 'The Miracle on the Hudson,' ditched into the Hudson River on January 15, 2009, Dave Sanderson knew he was exactly where he was supposed to be. As the last passenger off the back of the plane on that fateful day, he took responsibility for the well-being and safety of others. He risked his own life in the frigid water to help other passengers off the plane but despite the hazards to himself, Dave thought only of helping others. He emerged from the wreckage that day with a mission to encourage others to do the right thing.



Nichole Jolly - *"Reflections on the Paradise Fire"*

On 8 Nov 2018, a megafire swept through northern California. In its path was the town of Paradise. Within four hours, around 30,000 people had lost their homes. It was the deadliest fire in America for a century. Nichole Jolly was a nurse at the local hospital who evacuated her patients before finding herself trapped in the middle of the fire.



Cheryl Petersen-Kroeber - *"COVID-19 Looking Back, Looking Ahead"*

Cheryl will reflect on the long journey of Minnesota and the Nations COVID -19 response at the state, local and national level. She will highlight some of the successes and the challenges across government and across partners. She will share lessons learned and efforts to improve our efforts today and for the future.



Neal Petersen - *"There are No Barriers ~ Only Solutions!"*

Neal will share how he overcame the formidable barriers of a childhood physical disability, poverty and the humiliation of Apartheid in South Africa to compete in one of the most dangerous of all sports: solo yacht racing around the globe—27,000 miles, 9 months at sea—alone, and in a yacht he designed and built himself. Delivering a strong and timely message of adaptability and perseverance, Neal turns barriers into solutions by never giving up. He challenges audiences to find their treasures, to use their experiences to navigate these challenging times to their advantage.
